## The Letter K - Uppercase (page 18)

## **Materials:**

- alphabet chart or page 4
- uppercase K flashcard
- picture cards (iguana, jet, kite, kangaroo, kitten, kick, lion and any other previously taught picture cards)
- letter poster for **uppercase K** from previous lesson
- tracing card for uppercase K
- three pieces of string or pipe cleaners per student

**Review:** 3-5 minutes

- Sing the alphabet song while pointing at the letters
  - For students with less phonics exposure, the teacher should point to a wall chart while singing the song.
  - For students with more phonics exposure and experience, students should point to the letters on page 4 as they sing the song.
- Show the letter and kangaroo picture flashcard for the letter **Kk**, while saying the letter name, letter sound, the picture name, and stroke count while air writing. Students repeat.
  - o Teacher and students: "K, /k/, kangaroo"; air write and count letter strokes

**Preview:** 5-7 minutes

- Show the **uppercase K** letter poster and trace the letter, counting the letter strokes.
- Do body letters activity
  - o Discuss how **uppercase K** is made of one big line and two small lines.
  - Select three students and use their bodies to form the uppercase K on the floor.
  - Now put the students into groups of three and have them create an uppercase K with their bodies.

Modeling: 2-3 minutes

- Show the students the tracing card for **uppercase K**.
- String/Pipe Cleaner Letters Activity
  - Show students how to fit one piece of string/pipe cleaner inside the big straight line of the uppercase K.



 Show students how to fit one piece of string/pipe cleaner inside each of the small straight lines of the uppercase K.

**Guided Practice:** 5-10 minutes

- Pass out the tracing card for **uppercase K** to each student.
- Guide students to trace the **uppercase K** with their finger, counting the letter strokes. Repeat 2-3 times.
- Pass out one piece of string/pipe cleaner and have them hold it in the air to prevent them from going ahead.
- Guide students to fit one piece of string/pipe cleaner inside the straight line of the **uppercase K**.
- Pass out two more pieces of string/pipe cleaner and have them hold them in the air to prevent them from going ahead.
- Guide students to fit one piece of string/pipe cleaner inside each of the small straight lines of the **uppercase K**.

## **Independent Practice:** 3-5 minutes

- Have students straighten out their string/pipe cleaners and make another uppercase K.
  - Hint: If students say they are finished, tell them to straighten and create the uppercase K.
  - o *Idea*: If wanted, students could glue their string/pipe cleaner onto a piece of paper.

**Assessment:** (during Independent Practice)

- As the students are creating the **uppercase K**, the teacher walks around the room monitoring students' independent practice.
- Teacher gives guidance/support/correction/praise, as needed.
- Be sure to take note of students who may need more practice and/or instruction.

## Closure: 1-2 minutes

- Show the letter and kangaroo picture flashcard for the letter **Kk**, while saying the letter name, letter sound, the picture name, and stroke count while air writing. Students repeat.
  - o Teacher and students: "K, /k/, kangaroo"; air write and count letter strokes
